## FAQ: Federated Health Charities' Lottery

### (1) Where can I buy a lottery ticket?

Tickets are only sold online at <https://www.federatedhealth-lottery.ca/>.

### (2) How much do lottery tickets cost?

Each ticket cost \$5 + processing fees.

### (3) Why is there a processing fee for lottery tickets?

To meet the system integrity and security requirements for online gaming, the Federated Health Charities' Lottery is hosted in a separate platform from all other activities. This platform adds a processing fee to all purchases. This fee goes to the platform and is not sent to Federated Health Charities.

### (4) Will I receive a tax receipt for my lottery ticket purchases?

No. Payments for lottery are not eligible for a tax receipt.

### (5) When can I buy my lottery ticket?

Sales open on April 1, 2026, and close on June 26, 2026.

### (6) What are the lottery prizes?

An early bird draw will occur on May 13, 2026. The early bird winner will receive a prize of \$1000.

The remaining prizes, to be awarded at the end of the campaign period, include:

- (1) 1<sup>st</sup> Prize – \$15,000
- (2) 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize – \$5,000
- (3) 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize – \$3,000
- (4) 4<sup>th</sup> Prize – \$1,000

### (7) How do I know if I won the Federated Health lottery?

The draw will be held, and winners announced on June 30, 2026, at noon during the Federated Health Charities Campaign Celebration Event. Details about how to attend the event are available at <https://federatedhealth.ca>. Winners will also be contacted via telephone immediately following the Celebration Event.
