How We Choose What Charities to Support

Federated Health conducts an annual review of our charity list to assess for any gaps. This review considers who our donors have expressed wanting to see on the list, whether there are any communities being underserved by our charity list, and what pressing health needs there are in our communities.

How Much of a Donation Goes to the Charity

100% of a donation goes directly to the charity.

Who Do the Charities Serve

All our charities serve the entire province of Ontario and all its communities.

Where Can You Direct Your Donation

Donations can be directed to the charity of your choice or can be split amongst them all. You choose how much you want to give to each charity. Donations cannot be directed to specific local chapter of the charity.
